Our ROCK-A-THON 2011 "Harry Potter" party begins Friday, September 23, 2011 at 11:00 p.m. Check-in will begin promptly at 11:00 p.m. so arrive on time and get your night started!

All students raising a minimum of \$100 are eligible to attend the ROCK-A-THON party. Students may still qualify by turning in their money the night of the party. Students are to arrive at the gym mezzanine entrance between 11:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. Parents will be notified if a student is expected and fails to arrive. The ROCK-A-THON party will end at 6:00 a.m., September 24, 2011. Our weary chaperones will be anxious to get home, **so please be prompt in arriving for your student Saturday morning.**

Cobb County Policy requires that we have an "**Overnight Activity Permissions Form**" for each student attending. A parent or guardian **MUST sign** this form. These forms must be held by WBOP while students are attending the ROCK-A-THON lock-in party. This permission form is encouraged to be returned to the Band/Orchestra Room, prior to September 23rd. However, students can bring this permission form to ROCK-A-THON with them.

A student will not be allowed into the ROCK-A-THON party without a signed permission form; the parent may be retained in the parking lot or called at home to either sign a form or pick up the student

Once "locked-in," no student will be allowed to leave prior to the 6:00 a.m. ending time unless planning to use the 2:00 am early dismissal option by submitting an Early Release Permission Form. Students who plan to leave at 2:00 am must be picked up by 2:30 am or will be required to stay through the duration of the event until the regular 6:00 am dismissal time. All early dismissal students, regardless of age, must have a parent come into Walton to personally check them out with either Michele Brodsky (Orchestra) or Susan Corley (Band) before they will be allowed to leave. Students will **NOT** be allowed to return after leaving.

Students may WANT to bring:

- Camera (for own use and/or Photo Station)
- Sweats (Walton has two temperatures -- too hot or too cold), dress in layers
- Fold up chairs, mats, something "soft" to mark your "space" in the commons
- Gym shoes and socks are necessary for fun in the gym
