



Our ROCK-A- THON 2009 "Roman" party begins Friday, September 25, 2009 at 11:30 p.m. Check-in will begin promptly at 11:30 p.m. so arrive on time and get your night started!

All students raising a minimum of \$100 are eligible to attend the ROCK-A-THON party. Students may still qualify by turning in their money the night of the party. Students are to arrive at the gym mezzanine entrance between 11:30 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. Parents will be notified if a student is expected and fails to arrive. The ROCK-A-THON party will end at 6:00 a.m., September 26th. Our weary chaperones will be anxious to get home, **so please be prompt in arriving for your student Saturday morning.**

Cobb County Policy requires that we have an "**Overnight Activity Permissions Form**" for each student attending. A parent or guardian **MUST sign** this form. These forms must be held by WBOP while students are attending the ROCK-A-THON lock-in party. This permission form is encouraged to be returned to the Band Room, prior to September 25th. However, students can bring this permission form to ROCK-A- THON with them.

A student will not be allowed into the ROCK-A-THON party without a signed permission form; the parent may be retained in the parking lot or called at home to either sign a form or pick up the student

If students need to leave the ROCK-A-THON party for any reason, written permission from a parent or guardian must be given to Jean Graves (orchestra students) or Heidi Lipman (band students), both of whom will be onsite for the duration of the party. Once "locked-in," no one will be allowed to leave prior to the 6:00 a.m. ending time without written permission AND without confirming with the adults noted above, prior to departure. Students will NOT be allowed to return after leaving.
